Learning Entrepreneurship and Agriculture Practically (LEAP) aims at improving the quality of agriculture and entrepreneurship teaching and learning in Uganda's lower secondary (O-level) and secondary technical and vocational education and training (TVET) schools. The programme will be implemented over five years in National Teachers Colleges of Mubende, Unyama, Kabale and at the National Instructors College of Abilonino. Education Advisors operate from our *Uganda Country Office in Kampala*, with frequent travel to our operational partners.

Position of the Education Advisor

The LEAP programme will be implemented in national teachers' colleges of Mubende, Kabale and Unyama and the National Instructors College of Abilonino partnering with the Ministry of Education and Sports, and a range of other partners in the skilling, agriculture and education sectors.

The Education Advisor will be responsible for codesigning and delivering capacity development trajectories that ensure partners are able to design and test a new Continuous Professional Development package for in-service teachers and school leaders. The education advisor will also offer their expertise towards instructional design and blended learning in the context of pre-service training and capacity development trajectories. Together with other Advisors on the programme, they will support the quality and fidelity of implementation of the programme at the college level.

Education Advisors report to the Education Manager and work closely and directly with colleagues in the LEAP programme, the education department, and all other departments of VVOB in Uganda.



Learning Entrepreneurship and Agriculture Practically (LEAP), 2022-2026

The LEAP programme aims to improve the quality of agriculture and entrepreneurship teaching and learning in Uganda's lower secondary (O-level) and secondary technical and vocational education and training (TVET) schools. The programme introduces a model of effective, gender-responsive agriculture and entrepreneurship education that combines study and career guidance, project-based learning for agripreneurship, and work-based learning and that links schools to the agriculture world of work for the delivery of these three components. Over the course of five years, an estimated 250 pre-service BTVET instructors, 1,770 pre- and in-service O-level teachers and 250 in-service school leaders in the catchment areas of the National Instructors College Abilonino (NICA) and National Teachers Colleges (NTCs) Kabale, Mubende and Unyama will be equipped with the competences to do so, reaching 628,460 O-level learners and 13,715 learners in secondary TVET. These educators will benefit from quality pre-service and continuous professional development (CPD) opportunities provided by NICA and the three NTCs. This programme contributes to the achievement of Uganda's National Teachers Policy, Skilling Uganda agenda, SDG 4 (Quality Education) and contributes to the ILO's global commitment on Decent Jobs for Youth.



Result Areas:

Key responsibilities for Education Advisors are as follows:

- 1. You offer technical advice, guidance and support to partners and align and collaborate with internal VVOB colleagues to achieve project results and realize the educational change processes supported by the project.
- 2. You contribute to the identification, formulation, budgeting, implementation, monitoring and evaluation of the project that you are assigned to in order to realize the educational change processes supported by the project.
- 3. You take up a variety of roles in the **capacity development process** of the partners according to the needs of the partner and particular situations and phases of the programme;
- 4. You keep abreast with policy trends, new developments and latest research and thinking in agricultural education and training, positive youth development / youth economic empowerment and international development by external and internal **networking** and share new insights with partners and VVOB colleagues.

If you are our Education Advisor, your workweek will include the following highlights:



You will meet with college lecturers to review this term's results of a blended continuous professional development package for school leaders and O-level teachers.

You will prepare activity sheets and accompanying budgets for a capacity development trajectory on blended learning design for college lecturers and discuss your ideas with the your project coordinator and education manager.

Together with college lecturers you will prototype test EdTech solutions and ensure participant feedback is gathered to support decision making.

You will prepare our education partners to present at knowledge sharing events lessons learnt from prototyping continuous professional development trajectories following blended learning approaches.

You will lead a co-writing workshop with UNITE and NTCs to develop module content of a CPD package for school leaders.

You offer feedback to colleagues on the design of teaching and learning support materials.
